- Conducted an extensive media campaign to promote the Merry-Go-Round's 90 years of fun-filled "Ups and Downs";
- Made extensive repairs to the Merry-Go-Round's 91-year-old operating mechanism, including its gears and electrical system;
- Passed the annual safety inspection with flying colors, thanks to our dedicated staff and volunteers;
- Made major repairs to roof shingles that were significantly damaged by storms and squirrels;
- Replaced and upgraded exterior landscaping necessitated by changing the location of park sidewalks to better accommodate disabled visitors;
- Updated and replaced original bathroom fixtures;
- Continued annual painting of internal and external sections of our 26-year-old building.
